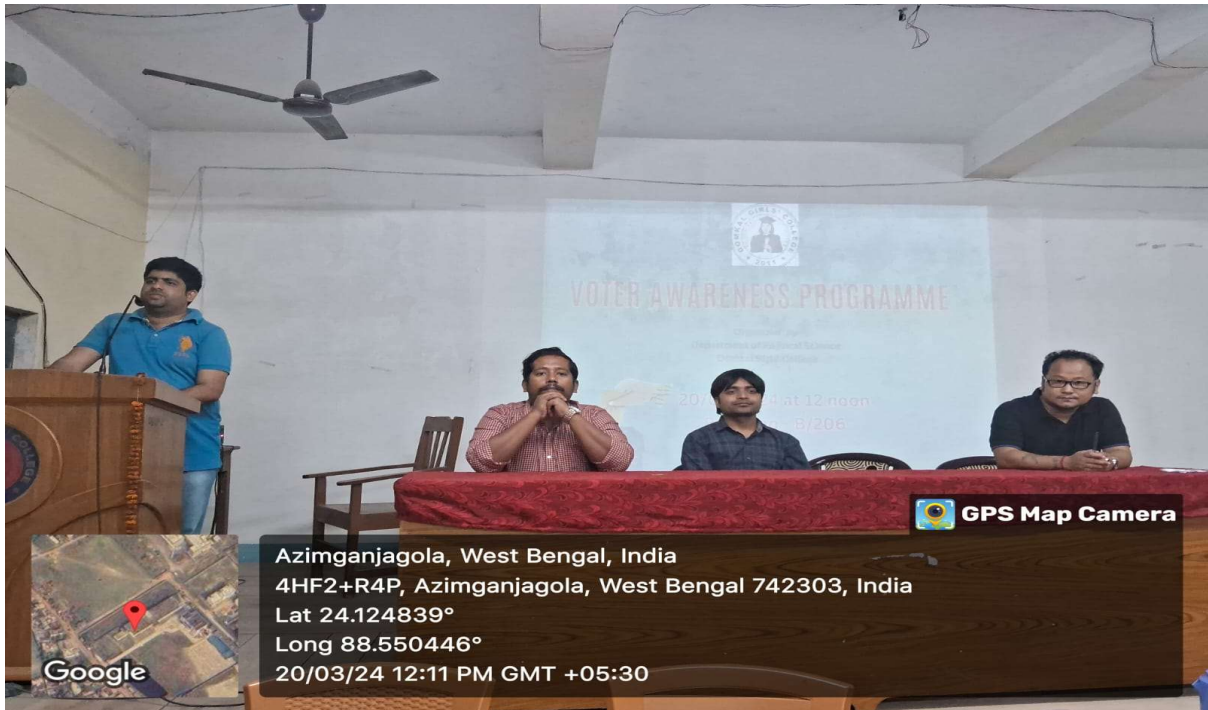
***INTRODUCTION:** The Department of Political Science, Domkal Girls' College organized a maiden awareness campaign on the indispensability of voting among the students against the backdrop of the upcoming Lok Sabha elections 2024 at the college auditorium. The event comprised the presence of faculties and students from multiple departments to ensure the successful commencement of the event.

STEERED BY: Mr. Rajib Sha (Assistant Professor), Mr. Gautam Tamang (Assistant Professor) and Mr. Al Mamun Hasan (SACT), Department of Political Science, Domkal Girls' College.

OBJECTIVE: The concerted effort and collaboration of the respective department with the active participation of the students and faculty members was undertaken with a view to mark the occasion of Voter awareness programme with an exclusive emphasis on the theme "Enfranchisement of the Youth". The format of the event comprised a flurry of activities in an attempt to sensitize the students about the importance of enfranchisement rights.

MERITS: The format of the event comprised a series of sessions dedicated to the overall context of the event. The event started positively at 12:00 PM at the auditorium of the college where the invitees included a motley combination of faculty members and students from multiple departments. The awareness campaign included a keynote address by the Hon'ble Principal, Dr. Alak Kumar Das. The preliminary address was delivered by the Head of the Department, Political Science, Mr. Rajib Saha which comprised a sensitizing lecture on the imperativeness of voting among the students especially the first-time voters in ensuring the successful functioning of democracy. A special lecture titled "Enfranchising the youth- the holistic merits of voting" was delivered by Mr. Gautam Tamang, Assistant Professor, Domkal Girls' College which traversed across the usual banalities of voting. The lecture addressed the prevailing scenario of enfranchisement with over 96 crore active voters and the presence of 1.84 crore first time voters. It addressed a series of issues pertaining to the imperativeness of voting, electoral reforms and the emergence of contemporary mechanisms for the electorate to ensure the exercise of free, transparent, fair and ethical voting.

EVENT OUTCOME: The successful fruition of the event was substantiated with the active participation of all the attendees, the interactive session witnessed thought provoking interactions among all the participants and a sensitization session with the introduction of a slew of empowerment mechanisms like Cvigil app, grievance redressal mechanisms etc. to the young students to acquaint them with the prerogatives and responsibilities of enfranchisement.
